The North 80 ft. of the West 300 ft. of Tract 49, Block 13, Alderwood Manor No. 14, according to the plat recorded in Volume 26 of Plats, page 4, records of King County, situate in King County, Washington.

and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the parcel owned by the King County Library System would be more beneficial to the County than the presently owned identical parcel because it would provide uninterrupted street frontage for the North Precinct site, and

WHEREAS, both King County and the King County Library
System have agreed to the exchange of the identical parcels,

by King County, in exchange for the identical parcel of land owned by the King County Library System, both of which are described in this motion.
