MOTION NO. 2282

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration, for funds in the amount of \$52,375 to support the installation of traffic control devices at the South 259th Street Railroad Crossing, Grant File No. 606.

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration, is empowered by the Highway Safety Act to make grant awards for the purpose of increasing highway safety, and

WHEREAS, the installation of traffic control devices will enhance the safety of highway users at the South 259th Street Railroad Crossing, and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County recognizes its obligation to provide \$5,820 in cash as a contribution towards the cost of the project,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$52,375 to the Federal Highway Administration.

2. The County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such applications and contracts as are required by the Federal Highway Administration.

3. The U.S. Government, Federal Highway Administration, is hereby assured of full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
