A MOTION approving the 1976 King County Plan for Drug Abuse Services and authorizing the County Executive to transmit the Plan to the State of Washington, Department of Social and Health Services.

WHEREAS, the State of Washington by RCW 69.54 and RCW 71.24 provides for financial assistance necessary to enable the State of Washington to offer a meaningful program of rehabilitation for those persons suffering problems related to narcotic drugs, dangerous drugs, and alcohol; and

WHEREAS, state law establishes a program designed to aid and rehabilitate persons suffering from problems relating to narcotic drugs, dangerous drugs, and alcohol; and

WHEREAS, state law provides for agreements by the state pursuant to the provisions of the Interlocal Cooperation Act to accomplish the purposes of RCW 71.24; and

WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 1763 established the Seattle-King County Drug Commission to correlate activities of all agencies in King County which are concerned with drug abuse problems and to apply, receive and expend funds from any source necessary to meet its purpose consistent with the appropriation authority of the respective governments.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The 1976 King County Plan for Drug Abuse Services is hereby approved by the Council of King County for consideration and approval by the State of Washington.

2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to transmit the County Plan for Drug Abuse Services to the Department of Social and Health Services for consideration and approval.

3. The Council intends that allocated funds to defray administrative expenses and support staff of the Division of Human Services shall also be used, as deemed appropriate, to carry out stated Council intent regarding management relationships

1 among the division, the Center for Addiction Services, and the  
 2 CAS affiliate agencies; PROVIDED THAT, any study of the division's  
 3 management relationships in the drug treatment field shall also  
 4 include study of the operational and decision-making relationship  
 5 of the Seattle-King County Drug Commission to that categorical  
 6 area; PROVIDED FURTHER THAT, this motion will not change the  
 7 Council's intent as specified in Motion No. 2361 which set limits  
 8 on the number of Division of Human Services staff.


9 4. The Council intends that by May 15, 1976, the division  
 10 shall supply the Health and Human Services Committee with 1975  
 11 historical performance data of clients served and estimates of  
 12 clients to be served, by modality, in 1976 under the provisions  
 13 of the 1976 Drug Abuse Services Plan.
