1 A MOTION proclaiming the week beginning
2 May 1, 1976 as Youth Week.

3 WHEREAS, the Benevolent and protective Order of Elks has
4 designated the week beginning May 1st, as Youth Week to honor
5 America's Junior Citizens for their accomplishments, and to give
6 fitting recognition of their services to Community, State and
7 Nation; and

8 WHEREAS, Lake City Elks Lodge #1800 will sponsor an
9 observance during that week in tribute to the Junior Citizens of
10 this Community; and

11 WHEREAS, no event could be more deserving of our support
12 and participation than one dedicated to these young people who
13 represent the nation's greatest resource, and who in the years
14 ahead will assume the responsibility for the advancement of our
15 free society; and


16 WHEREAS, our Youth need the guidance, inspiration and
