MOTION NO. 2425

A MOTION adopting the recommendations of the Policy Options in the Park and Recreation Study.

WHEREAS, the Forward Thrust Park Program, the first county-wide, coordinated and comprehensive development program for parks and recreation facilities is scheduled for completion in 1979, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizing the need to better identify the County's post Forward Thrust role in park and recreation, requested the Executive to complete a study addressing the feasibility and desirability of consolidating park and recreation functions with the City of Seattle and other municipalities, and

WHEREAS, the study Policy Options in Park and Recreation has been completed and discussed by the County Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Council hereby adopts and requests the County Executive to implement the recommendations of the Policy Options in Parks and Recreation Study as set forth below:

1. Once basic policy directions have been established by the elected officials, it is recommended that a Master Plan and Program be prepared detailing the post Forward Thrust park needs of King County up to the year 2000.


2. Clearer policies should be established governing the ownership and maintenance of open space and recreational land ceded to the public in the course of planned unit developments.

1 3. A revolving fund or similar procedure would be
2 desirable to give more flexibility to the scheduling of cultural
3 arts and crafts classes if such recreation programs are continued
4 as a county function.

5 4. Management attention should be given to the revision
6 of fees and charges for the use of county park facilities to
7 reflect the current cost of utilities and maintenance, and for
8 the use of facilities where special services such as field lining
9 or dragging are required.
