A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the Department of Social and Health Services for funds in the approximate amount of \$260,337 to support Mental Health Special Local Need Programs, Grant file No. 625:2.

WHEREAS, the State Department of Social and Health Services is empowered to make grants to support Mental Health Special Local Need Programs, and

WHEREAS, the King County Mental Health Plan for 1976 identifies as priorities services to seriously disturbed adults, seriously disturbed youth, and seriously disturbed elderly persons, and

WHEREAS, the services provided by the Seattle Childrens Home, Ravenna Developmental Center, Community House, Seattle Mental Health Institute, Valley Cities Mental Health Center, Mental Health North, Highline-West Seattle Mental Health Center and Conbela meet the needs of such youth, adults and elderly persons and can be augmented through the Special Local Needs Programs, and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds that augmentation of such services is in the public interest,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$260,337 to the Department of Social and Health Services, Bureau of Mental Health, on behalf of King County;

2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the State; Provided, That the contract contains assurances that the state will increase the county's grant-in-aid award for support of these programs in the future; and Provided Further That, before an appropriation is made, the budget for indirect costs is approved by the Finance, Audit and Budget Committee of


the King County Council;

3. The County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;


4. The United States of America, Department of Justice, and the State of Washington, are hereby assured full compliance with Title IV and Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
