A MOTION granting an easement in favor of King County Water District No. 90 over Cedar River Park.

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 90, a municipal corporation of King County, Washington, has made application for the right to construct and maintain a sewer trunk line and a water line under and across a strip of land which is a portion of Cedar River Park, and

WHEREAS, investigation reveals that it would be to the County's advantage to grant to Water District No. 90 the easement described herein, and

WHEREAS, it is determined to be necessary and in the best interests of the citizens of King County that the said easement be granted in and for the consideration of mutual benefits, together with the right of King County to make two side sewer connections, which right will offset the value placed upon the easement requested by the District,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is authorized to sign and deliver the necessary sewer and water line agreement, granting to Water District No. 90 the easement described as follows:

A strip of land, 15 feet in width, parallel to and contiguous with the Burlington Northern Railway Right of Way, on and across the following described parcels:

That portion of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 22, Township 23 North, Range 5 East, W.M., lying Easterly of the Cedar River and Northerly of the Burlington Northern Rail-way Right of Way, (being a portion of Government Lot 10 and of the abandoned bed of the Cedar River);

Portion of Government Lots 3 and 8 in Section 22, Township 23 North, Range 5 East, W.M., lying Northerly of the Burlington
