MOTION NO. 2459

A MOTION stating the County Council's intention to establish a countywide program providing the elderly and disabled or handicapped with an identification card entitling them to various discounts throughout King County and directing the County Executive to prepare an ordinance incorporating the necessary appropriated funds to administer the program.

WHEREAS, identification cards for senior citizens, the handicapped or disabled and certain low income elderly are being issued by various governmental agencies, and

WHEREAS, those persons issued such cards are receiving reductions and/or exemptions from governmentally regulated fees (i.e., Metro Transit, pet license fees, taxi rates, etc.) and

WHEREAS, King County has no identification program for those individuals living in the unincorporated area, other than Metro Transit,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council hereby directs the County Executive to prepare an ordinance, for Council consideration, establishing a program to provide an identification card to those individuals who shall verify to one of the following qualifications:

1. 65 years of age or older,
2. disabled or handicapped,
3. 62 years of age or older or disabled or handicapped and a combined annual income of less than \$4,000 if single or less than \$6,000 if married.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED, that such ordinance shall include the appropriation of funds necessary to administer such program.
