

MOTION NO. 2472

A MOTION requesting the deletion of Lakemont Boulevard (Project 405571) from the King County 1976 Capital Improvement Program and revising the Department of Public Works and Transportation Program, Streets and Roads Construction Sub-Program, Capital Improvement Program.

WHEREAS, the King County Executive through his memorandum dated April 23, 1976 recommended removal of Lakemont Boulevard from the 1976 Capital Improvement Program pending completion of a comprehensive community and transportation plan for the entire Newcastle area, and

WHEREAS, the King County Executive requested in that memorandum, guidance from the King County Council regarding the proposed Lakemont Boulevard project,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is directed to forward an ordinance for consideration by the King County Council which deletes Project 405571 - Lakemont Boulevard - in the Department of Public Works and Transportation Program, 1976 Streets and Roads Construction Sub-Program, Capital Improvement Program.

2. Said ordinance shall provide that no obligation shall be incurred against the appropriation for Project 405571 - Lakemont Boulevard - after the effective date of the subject ordinance.

3. Said ordinance shall further provide that the balance of the 1976 Budget carried forward from 1975 for Project 405571 - Lakemont Boulevard - after provision for obligations against it through the effective date of said ordinance shall be available for other capital project purposes, as provided for in subsequent Capital Improvement Program decisions.
