ORDINANCE NO. 2481

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to a proposed amendment  
2 of Article 6, King County Charter, submitting  
3 same to the voters of the County and estab-  
4 lishing date of election.

4 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 SECTION 1. There shall be submitted to the qualified  
6 voters of the county for their approval and ratification or  
7 rejection, at the next general election to be held in this  
8 county, an amendment to Article 6 of the King County Charter:

9 amending Section 610 thereof to read as follows:

10 "Except as provided in this Article, the nominating  
11 primaries and elections shall be conducted in accordance with  
12 general law governing the election of ((partisan)) nonpartisan  
13 county officers."

14 deleting Section 620 thereof, and  
15 renumbering Sections 630 through 690 to reflect the deletion  
16 of Section 620.

17 SECTION 2. The Director of the Division of Records and  
18 Elections shall cause notice of the proposed amendment of the  
19 King County Charter to be published in accordance with the state  
20 constitution and general law.
