

1 A MOTION granting a sewer easement over part of Lakota
2 Park to the Lakehaven Sewer District; and authorizing
the County Executive to sign the required instrument.

3 WHEREAS, the Lakehaven Sewer District desires an easement for a sewer
4 trunk line over a portion of Lakota Park, and

5 WHEREAS, the King County Council has determined it to be necessary and
6 in the best interests of the citizens of King County that the said easement
7 be granted in and for the consideration of mutual benefits, and the dele-
8 tion of sewer assessment penalties on the Lakota Park property,

9 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


10 The County Executive is hereby authorized to sign and deliver the nec-
11 essary sewer trunk line easement, granting to the Lakehaven Sewer District,
12 an easement over, across, along, in, upon and under County owned property
13 situated in King County and more particularly described as follows:

14 That portion of NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Section 12, Town-
15 ship 21 North, Range 3 East, W.M., lying SEly of the
16 Robert Maltby Road (SR 509) included within a strip
of land 30 feet in width, the centerline of which is
described as follows:


17 Commencing at the East 1/4 corner of said Section 12;
18 thence South 1°11'27" West 814.31 feet to the true
19 point of beginning; thence North 8°25'10" West 387.08
20 feet; thence North 38°28'39" West 350.02 feet; thence
North 13°23'15" West 8 feet, more or less, to an
intersection with the SEly margin of said Robert
Maltby Road (SR 509).
