A MOTION requiring a planned unit development as a condition to the approval of a reclassification petitioned by SALUS ASSOCIATES, designated Building and Land Development File No. 103-76-R.

WHEREAS, SALUS ASSOCIATES, a partnership, has applied for a reclassification of certain property from B-C and C-G to C-G under Building and Land Development File No. 103-76-R; and,

WHEREAS, the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner by report dated April 13, 1976 has recommended that the property be classified CG-P, in lieu of C-G, subject to conditions; and,

WHEREAS, the Council adopts Findings No. 1 through No. 6 and Conclusions Nos. 1, 2, and 4 as set forth in the Examiner's report and incorporates them here by reference; and,

WHEREAS, the Council finds that a single-family residential area is situated adjacent to the east boundary of the property; and,

WHEREAS, the Council makes the following conclusions:

- 1. The subject property should not be developed with General Commercial uses unless the single-family residences east of the site are protected from the adverse impacts of such uses.
- 2. The protection of the single-family area east of the site can best be assured through the planned unit development process rather than by administrative review of site plans. The planned unit development process would allow public comment upon proposed development plans and would allow the Council to review those plans.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
The application for reclassification of property from B-C and
C-G to C-G petitioned by SALUS ASSOCIATES under Building and
Land Development File No. 103-76-R is approved, subject to the
following conditions:

1. The applicant shall obtain approval of a preliminary planned unit devleopment for the subject property within 18 months from the date of this motion; and the applicant shall obtain approval of final planned

unit development plans within 24 months from the date of this motion. The notice of public hearing on the preliminary planned unit development, which is mailed by the Division of Building and Land Development, shall include the single-family residences running easterly from the subject property to the east side of Interlake Avenue North.
