A MOTION approving the use of \$35,000 of Revenue Sharing Funds, allocated as part of the county's Human Service Allocation Process, to implement the Summer Highline Recreation Plan.

WHEREAS, the Council and the Executive have been involved in a effort to allocate \$165,000 in Revenue Sharing Funds to human services programs meeting funding criteria established by the county, and

WHEREAS, the Executive has recommended the funding of a program entitled the Summer Highline Recreation Plan at a cost of \$35,000, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Summer Highline Recreation Plan Program is to utilize school district facilities and staff to provide a summer program of activities for elementary and junior high school children in the Highline and Federal Way School Districts, and

WHEREAS, the program will involve thousands of children in the Highline and Federal Way area and requires substantial planning and coordination between the school district, the county, and enrolling children, prior to actual activities beginning, and

WHEREAS, unless coordinative staff can be hired immediately and all parties are assured that the program will begin on the scheduled date, the program is in danger of not being implemented.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Council approves the use of \$35,000 in earmarked Revenue Sharing Funds to fund the Summer Highline Recreation Plan and requests that the executive aid program staff in quickly implementing the program.
