2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to  
3 execute and submit a grant application to the  
4 Department of Social & Health Services for  
5 funds in the approximate amount of \$212,385  
6 to support Mental Health Special Projects,  
7 Grant file No. 639:2.

8 WHEREAS, the State Department of Social & Health Services is  
9 empowered to make grants to support Mental Health Special Projects,  
10 and

11 WHEREAS, the King County Mental Health Plan for 1976 indenti-  
12 fies as priorities services to seriously disturbed adults, ser-  
13 iously disturbed youth, and seriously disturbed elderly persons,  
14 and

15 WHEREAS, the Projects proposed for the Seattle Indian  
16 Health, Youth Eastside Services, Community Psychiatric Clinic,  
17 Harborview Community Mental Health Center, and Eastside Community  
18 Mental Health Center meet the needs of such youth, adults and  
19 elderly persons and can be provided through Special Project  
20 Funding, and

21 WHEREAS, the Council of King County supports the priorities  
22 assigned by the King County Mental Health Board to the five  
23 proposed projects in the order shown above, and

24 WHEREAS, the funds for Mental Health Special Projects are  
25 made available by the State for singular non-renewable grants, no  
26 liability is assumed by King County to provide any additional  
27 support to any project, and

28 WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds that provision of  
29 such services is in the public interest,

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

31 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make  
32 application for funds in the approximate amount of \$212,385 to the  
33 Department of Social & Health Services, Bureau of Mental Health,  
on behalf of King County;


1           2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed  
2 to file and execute such application and contracts as are required  
3 by the State;

4           3. The County Executive is also authorized to enter into and  
5 execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation  
6 of the project;

7           4. The United States of America, and the State of  
8 Washington, are hereby assured full compliance with Title IV and  
9 Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
