

MOTION NO. 2552

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A MOTION confirming the five appointments of the County Executive to the King County Noxious Weed Control Board for initial terms of office of two years for three voting members and one year for two voting members.

WHEREAS, the inactive King County Noxious Weed Control Board was activated by King County Council Motion No. 1908 on March 17, 1975, as provided for in RCW 17.10, and

WHEREAS, the King County Executive through the Department of Public Works and Transportation in cooperation with the County Cooperative Extension Service has provided a suggested division of the five districts, an estimated yearly operating cost of approximately \$27,000 for initial and annual office supplies, chemicals, equipment, labor, part-time secretarial support and miscellaneous expenses, and

WHEREAS, the King County Charter gives the power of appointment to the County Executive subject to the confirmation of a majority of the County Council (Section 340.10 and .40),

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The following five appointments are confirmed to serve as members of the King County Noxious Weed Control Board by the district and its boundaries described below and as shown on the attached map and by reference incorporated herein, and

FURTHER, That the initial terms of office are as indicated below after each appointee:

DISTRICT #1: All that portion of unincorporated King County, Washington, lying Northerly of Interstate Highway 90 and Westerly of the Snoqualmie River and the South Fork of the Snoqualmie River.



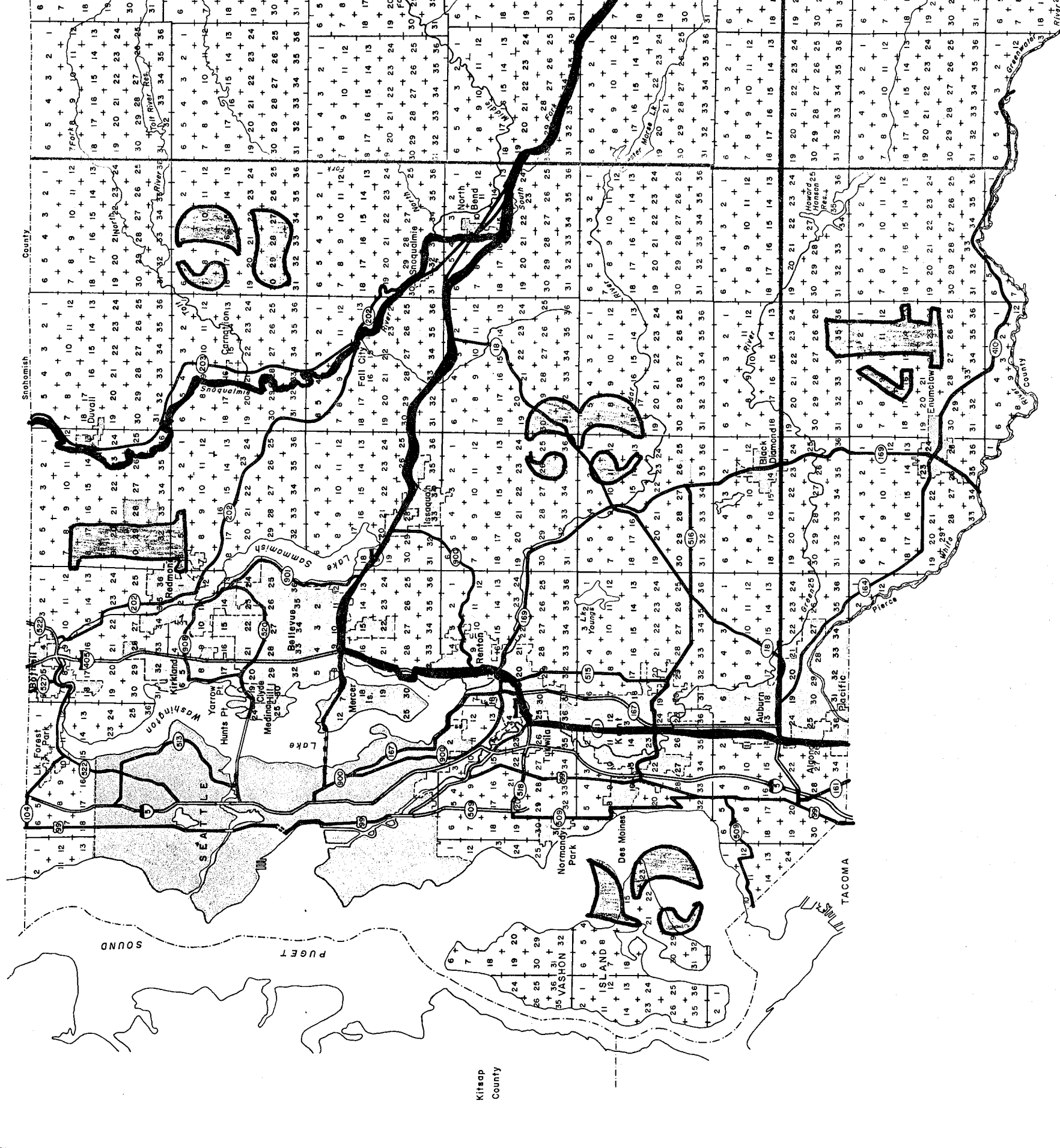
