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## MOTION NO. 2559

A MOTION concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner regarding the Proposed Plat of VASHON EAST designated Building and Land Development File No. 576-12, and adding a condition thereto.

WHEREAS, the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner by report dated May 18, 1976 has recommended approval of the Proposed Plat of VASHON EAST, Building and Land Development File No. 576-12; and

WHEREAS, the Examiner's recommendation has been appealed by property owners residing in the vicinity of the proposed plat; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has reviewed the record and written appeal arguments in this matter; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that evidence of environmental impact relating to the proposed action and reasonable alternatives to the proposed action have been included in the review and consideration of the proposed plat; and

WHEREAS, the Council adopts the findings and conclusions set forth in the Examiner's report and incorporates them here by reference; and

WHEREAS, based upon the whole record and according substantial weight to the determination of environmental significance made by the Division of Building and Land Development, the Council concludes that approval of the proposed plat subject to conditions would not constitute a major action significantly affecting the quality of the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council concludes that a condition should be added to the conditions recommended by the Examiner in order to clarify the Council's intent regarding the berming and landscaping protection afforded the appellants; and

WHEREAS, the Council concludes that the appeal should be 1 2 denied, NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: 3 The Proposed Plat of VASHON EAST, designated Building and Land Development File No. 576-12, is approved subject to the 5 6 conditions recommended by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner 7 in his report dated May 18, 1976 and subject to the following 8 additional condition: 9 CONDITION 7(1): 10 The earth berming and landscaping required by Item 7(k) above shall remain as a permanent installation except for modification in driveway plans which are 11 approved by the Building and Land Development Division 12 at the time of the development of Lot 2.
