

MOTION NO. 2562

A MOTION confirming the appointment of Paul T. Edgerton by the County Executive to the King County Building Code Advisory and Appeals Board and whose term expires April 1, 1978.

WHEREAS, King County Code 16.08.020 authorized the creation of a Building Code Advisory and Appeals Board, consisting of thirteen members to "determine the suitability of alternate materials and methods of construction and to provide for reasonable interpretations of" the Uniform Building Code as modified for King County, and

WHEREAS, the members of the above said Board shall be appointed by the County Executive and confirmed by a majority of the County Council as provided for in K.C.C. 16.08.020 and in the King County Charter Section 340.10, and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has appointed Paul T. Edgerton to fill an existing vacancy on above said Board, and

WHEREAS, the County Council finds Paul T. Edgerton to be qualified for membership on above said Board by his experience and training to pass upon matters pertaining to building construction,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Council hereby confirms the appointment of Paul T. Edgerton by the County Executive to serve as a member of the King County Building Code Advisory and Appeals Board and whose term expires April 1, 1978.
