2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to enter
3 into a contract with Water District No. 119 for a
4 revised franchise to combine Franchise No. 594 with
the Lake Joy area, to construct, maintain and operate
a water system.

5 WHEREAS, Water District No. 119, as provided in RCW 36.55.010
6 of the State of Washington, has properly filed an application for
7 revision of franchise 594, to construct, maintain and operate a
8 water system , and

9 WHEREAS, Resolution 75-2 of the Utilities Technical Review
10 Committee certifies that the comprehensive plan of said water
11 district has been reviewed and deemed to be in compliance with
12 Ordinance 1709 and Section 13.24 of the King County Code and have
13 recommended approval of the plan by the Council, and

14 WHEREAS, the application has been referred to the County
15 Executive for investigation of the feasibility thereof and the
16 checking of the plans and description of the location thereof.

18 WHEREAS, Environmental Policy requirements have been met as
19 provided under Ordinance 2674, Section 4, paragraph g, and

20 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended approval of
21 said franchise.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, be it moved by the Council of King County;


23 The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into and
24 execute the attached water system franchise contract for Water
25 District No. 119, which by this reference, is incorporated herein
26 as part of the Motion. Said franchise is granted to Water
27 District No. 119 for the term of Seventeen (17) years, and
28 includes a legal description of the location and all of the general
29 and special conditions required by the County.

30 If withn Thirty (30) days after the granting of this

1 franchise the applicant shall have failed to sign the incorpor-
2 ated written acceptance herein, then the herein granted rights
3 and privileges shall be deemed forfeited and said franchise
4 shall be declared null and void.
