A MOTION relating to Council policy on a publicly owned and operated solid waste collection system in unincorporated King County.

WHEREAS, the King County Solid Waste Utility Plan prepared by the Solid Waste Division in September 1975 seems to imply that King County intends to institute a publicly owned and operated solid waste collection system in unincorporated King County to replace the currently operating private system, and

WHEREAS, such action would ultimately require approval by the King County Council following appropriate changes in the state law, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has not expressed itself as a matter of policy on the issue,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council as a matter of policy has no intention of instituting a publicly owned and operated solid waste collection system in unincorporated King County to replace the currently operating private system and any implications to the contrary have no standing with the Council.
