

MOTION NO. 2608

A MOTION of the County Council of King County, Washington, retaining counsel for certain services in connection with the issuance, sale and delivery of bonds of King County Road Improvement Districts No's. 46, 59, 63, 64, 65, 67, 71, and 73.

WHEREAS, King County has heretofore duly created and established King County Road Improvement District No's. 46, 59, 63, 64, 65, 67, 71 and 73 to carry out various road improvements as authorized by law within the County, and it is necessary to issue bonds of such road improvement districts to complete the financing thereof; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and in the best interests of King County and its inhabitants that nationally recognized attorneys experienced in such matters be retained as bond counsel to participate with the King County Prosecuting Attorney in reviewing the proceedings had to date in each of such road improvement districts, in drafting any additional proceedings as may be necessary, and to give their opinion as to the validity of the bonds to be issued in each of such road improvement districts at the time of their sale;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: Riddell, Williams, Ivie, Bullitt and Walkinshaw, attorneys-at-law, of Seattle, Washington, are hereby employed by the County to act as bond counsel to the County in connection with the issuance and sale of bonds of King County Road Improvement Districts No's. 46, 59, 63, 64, 65, 67, 71, and 73;

The services to be rendered by said law firm is participation in review of the transcript of proceedings had to date in each of said road improvement districts and in the drafting of any additional proceedings as may be required through the issuance and sale of the bonds of each of said road improvement districts, and the furnishing of an approving legal opinion upon the validity of such bonds at the time of the delivery thereof to the purchasers;


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1 The County shall pay Riddell, Williams, Ivie, Bullitt and
 2 Walkinshaw the sum of \$350.00 plus \$2.00 per \$1,000.00 par value
 3 of such bonds issued in excess of \$50,000.00 par value for each
 4 issue of such road improvement district bonds, such payments to
 5 be made out of the proceeds of such bonds when issued; and


6 The County shall furnish Riddell, Williams, Ivie, Bullitt
 7 and Walkinshaw a complete certified transcript of all proceedings
 8 had in connection with the issuance of such bonds of each road
 9 improvement district in order to enable said firm to furnish its
 10 approving legal opinion as to the validity thereof at the time of
 11 the sale of such bonds.
