 A MOTION requesting the Washington State Highway Commission to fund its portion of the Avondale Connector in its Operating Program for 1977 - 79, and fund the SR 520 missing link as soon as possible.

WHEREAS, the Redmond area is a major growth area in the State of Washington and the major growth area in King County, and

WHEREAS, the Redmond area provides a significant number of vehicle origin and destination trips, and

WHEREAS, the Redmond area's major commercial vehicle and passenger vehicle traffic traverse the city's central business district to reach major west, north and south travel routes, and

WHEREAS, the heavy traffic on Redmond Way through the city results in deleterious impacts to the populace of the area in congestion, noise, air pollution, aesthetics, road dirt and litter, wasted commuting time and inefficient energy use, and

WHEREAS, a route which would alleviate the foregoing undesirable effects has been planned (SR 520 missing link between SR 901 and 148th Avenue North and the Avondale Connector) partially completed (Highway 920 east from the Sammamish River to Redmond Way) or is now under construction (the bridge over the Sammamish River connecting SR 920 on the east and West Lake Sammamish Parkway or SR 901 on the west) and

WHEREAS, the Avondale Connector (Capital Improvement Program Project number 215471) is planned to be under construction in 1977 to connect the eastern terminus of SR 920 at Redmond Way and Avondale Road, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Highway Department has some 800 feet of the Avondale Connector within its right of way, and

WHEREAS, King County and the Washington State Highway

Department have mutually agreed to cooperate in the project with

the department doing the construction,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The Washington State Highway Commission is respectfully requested to include its portion of the Avondale Connector in its 1977 - 79 Operating Program so that it may be included in the cooperative project which the county intends to fund for construction starting in 1977. FURTHER, the Commission fund as soon as possible the completion of the SR 520 missing link between SR 901 West Lake Sammamish Parkway and 148th Avenue Northeast. PASSED this 2nd day of August, 1976.
