A MOTION declaring Motion 2629, passed August 9, 1976 no longer in effect and approving the City of Seattle Hearing Examiner's recommendation to approve the increases in rates and charges for cable television services established by Teleprompter within unincorporated King County, effective October 1, 1975, from \$7.95 to \$8.95 per month.

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds that Motion 2629 passed August 9, 1976 contains an error of fact in its WHEREAS section, and

WHEREAS, THE Seattle City Council and the King County Council are authorized by ordinances and franchise agreements to regulate rates and services relative to cable television services and

WHEREAS, the Teleprompter Corporation, on October 1, 1975 increased its primary monthly subscriber rates within the City of Seattle and within unincorporated King County from \$7.95 to \$8.95 per month, and

WHEREAS, both the Seattle City Council and the King County Council on their own motions, delegated to the Seattle Hearing Examiner the authority to hold a public hearing to review the rate increases and forward to the respective councils the complete record of the proceedings together with the written recommendation based on the findings and conclusions, and

WHEREAS, the hearing to review the rate increases for Teleprompter was held at 9:30 am and 1:30 pm, respectively on February 19, 1976, and

WHEREAS, the City Hearing Examiner's Conclusions of Law found the rate increases placed in effect by Teleprompter to be in the public interest and recommended that they should be allowed to remain in effect, and

WHEREAS, the City Hearing Examiner recommends that the Seattle City Council and the King County Council should approve the rate increases established by Teleprompter within the City of Seattle and within unincorporated King County effective October 1, 1975.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

Motion 2629, passed August 9, 1976 is no longer in effect,

and the King County Council approves the City Hearing Examiner's

recommendation that the rate increases established by Teleprompter

from \$7.95 to \$8.95 per month within unincorporated King County,

effective October 1, 1975, are in the public interest and should

be allowed to remain in effect.
