MOTION NO. _____

1 A MOTION authorizing and requesting the
2 County Executive to take the necessary
3 steps to designate a property site in
4 Federal Way for the construction of
needed District Court facilities; solicit
5 bids for the construction of said facilities.

6 WHEREAS, the facility currently leased by the county, housing
7 the Federal Way District Court has been sold, and

8 WHEREAS, the new owner of the facility will not extend the
9 current lease held by the county beyond November 14, 1977, and

10 WHEREAS, the county is bound by statutory responsibility to
11 provide permanent quarters for the Federal Way District Court
beyond the termination date of the current lease, and

12 WHEREAS, population projections and the requirements of State
13 law indicate that the Federal Way District Court shall by 1980 be
14 a two judge court, where it currently has the facilities for the
15 single full-time judgeship allocated to that court, and

16 WHEREAS, a task force of Federal Way citizens are proposing
17 alternative property sites for the location of a Federal Way
18 District Court Facility, including facilities for the district
19 court, and

20 WHEREAS, a prioritized list of approved property sites has
21 been submitted to the county by the task force of Federal Way
22 citizens, and

23 WHEREAS, appropriate executive staff have evaluated property
24 sites and are prepared to make a recommendation as to the final
25 site for the construction of a District Court Facility, and

26 WHEREAS, the county by competitive bid may solicit the
27 acquisition of designated property within Federal Way for con-
28 struction of a Federal Way District Court Facility to be leased
29 to the county, with the county retaining the right to purchase
30 the property and constructed facilities,




NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County;
