A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the State Law and Justice Planning Office for funds in the amount of \$3,611 for the support of the King County Juvenile Court Research Intern, Grant File No. 656:2.

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U. S. Department of Justice through the Washington State Law and Justice Planning Office, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council recognizes the need to support the King County Juvenile Court Research Intern Project, and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes its obligation to provide as support to this program \$401 as a cash match,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$3,611. to the State Law and Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the State;

3. The County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;

4. The United States of America, Department of Justice, and the State of Washington are hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
