A MOTION expressing the gratitude and appreciation of the King County Council to Ray Olsen for his efforts in developing and implementing the county's alcoholism program.

WHEREAS, Ray Olsen has spent more than twenty-five years working in the field of alcoholism treatment and rehabilitation, and

WHEREAS, he sponsored the original state legislation which provided funds for alcoholism research and treatment, and

WHEREAS, he was instrumental in developing King County's program at the Cedar Hills Alcoholism Treatment Center and a building there bears his name, and

WHEREAS, he was a charter member of the Seattle-King County Commission on Alcoholism, and


WHEREAS, he is Secretary of the 1980 annual convention of the National Council on Alcoholism;
