

MOTION NO. 2725

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit applications to the U.S. Economic Development Administration for funds under Title I of the Local Public Works Employment Act of 1976.

WHEREAS, Title I of the Local Public Works Employment Act of 1976 provides for the award of funds by the Economic Development Administration, U.S. Department of Commerce, to fund local government public works projects, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council recognizes that King County has several needed public works projects which will provide long term benefits to the citizens of King County as well as provide employment opportunities to the unemployed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

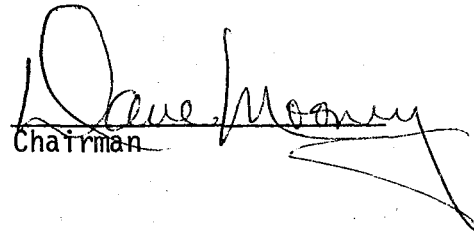
1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make applications for funds under Title I of the Public Works Employment Act of 1976 for projects contained on the Public Works project sheet attached hereto.
2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such applications and contracts as are required by the Economic Development Administration, U.S. Department of Commerce.
3. The Intergovernmental Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County, and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the Economic Development Administration.
4. The County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such construction contracts as are necessary for the implementation of successful project applications.

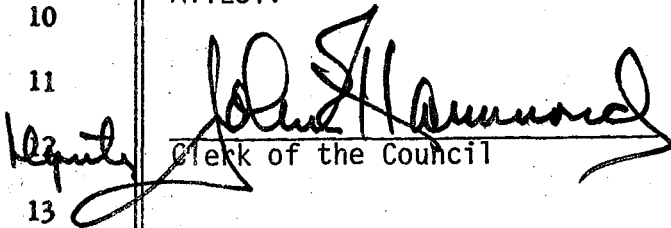
5. The United States of America, Department of Justice, and the State of Washington are hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
