A MOTION authorizing the commitment of additional funds from the Housing and Community Development Block Grant Program for the White Center/Southwest Suburban Sewer District Sewer Project.

WHEREAS, King County is due to recover adequate funds from the County share of 1975 "Population Monies" and

WHEREAS, the Southwest Suburban Sewer District submitted a proposal for a sewer project to cost \$962,900 with the understanding that the participating property owners would assign the sewer right-of-way easements to the District at no cost and that King County provided 50% of the proposed cost (CD-27-75 for \$100,000 and CD-174-76 for \$381,450) and,

WHEREAS, the project cost is predicted to exceed \$962,900 and the District is prepared to bear the excess cost prior to easement cost, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Regulations mandate that each of the participating property owners must be notified that they can be reimbursed for the value of the easement, and

WHEREAS, such notification and request for payment by the property owner could further increase the project cost up to an estimated \$15,000 and this potential added cost would be considered an unusual extra added cost to the project, and

WHEREAS, reimbursement to the Sewer District for added easement costs would only be made after it is ascertained that the remainder of the project did in fact incur costs exceeding \$962,900 and that the costs for easements does not increase the County share beyond 50%


