be in maximum harmony with the surrounding community, NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: 2 The subject property petitioned by CHESTER O. & JANICE K. 3 HOBERG, ET AL, and designated as Building and Land Development File No. 127-76-R be reclassified B-C-P subject to the criteria 5 6 for site plan approval recommended by the Deputy Zoning and 7 Subdivision Examiner in his report dated August 25, 1976 with the addition of the following condition: 8 9 The Building and Land Development Division shall determine at the time of site plan approval that a good faith effort has been made by the applicant, 10 or his representative, to meet with residents of the adjacent community to explore options in the 11 development of the site plan, particularly with 12 respect to landscape requirements, and to review the site plan as submitted for approval.
