

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to grant an easement and right of way in favor of the City of Bellevue. File No. 5-9-396

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue desires to install and maintain a sewer line with connections, manholes and appurtenances on certain lands, owned by King County and located in the Weowna Beach parkland, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has determined it to be in the best interests of the citizens of King County that the said easement and right of way be granted in and for the consideration of

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby authorized to sign and deliver the necessary agreement granting to the City of Bellevue an easement and right of way, over, through, under, across, and upon the following described real property situated in King County:

That portion of the S.E. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 1, Township 24 North, Range 5 East, W.M., described as follows:

A strip of land 20 feet in width, extending 10 feet on each side of the following described centerline:

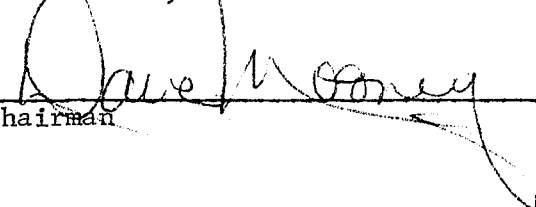
Beginning at the N.W. corner of said S.E. 1/4; Thence South 0°00'04" East 885.00 feet; Thence East 13.00 feet to the Easterly right of way line of 168th Avenue S.E., which is the true point of beginning; Thence South 54°00'00" East 110.00 feet; Thence South 5°30'00" East 370.00 feet to the South boundary of said Section 1.

Together with a strip of land 10 feet in width extending 5 feet on each side of the following described centerline:

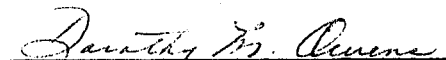
Beginning at the N.W. corner of said S.E. 1/4; Thence South 0°00'04" East 1180.00 feet to the true point of beginning; Thence due East 100.00 feet to the intersection with the centerline of the 20 foot easement first described herein.
