MOTION NO. 2743

A MOTION of the King County Council authorizing a memorandum agreement with the City of Seattle acting as the administrative agency for the Commuter Pool Program for joint participation by the County in the FY 1977 program.

WHEREAS, King County in 1973/1974 supported and jointly participated with the City of Seattle and others in a "pilot carpool demonstration project," and

WHEREAS, the pilot carpool demonstration project served as the basis for the Regional Carpool Program (Share and Save) in 1975, most recently named Commuter Pool Program, funded under the provisions of the Emergency Highway Energy Conservation Act, and

WHEREAS, the County has since continued to support the carpooling effort by dedicating a portion of its share of the Federal Aid to Urban Systems fund to the Urban Systems Board "regional project pot," and

WHEREAS, the 1976 Federal-Aid Highway Act amends Section 3 of the Emergency Highway Energy Conservation Act to include "carpooling opportunities to the elderly and the handicapped" and defines carpool to include vanpools, and

WHEREAS, King County has the expertise and resources to address suburban and unincorporated area issues, and

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle serves as the administrative agency for the Commuter Pool Program, and

WHEREAS, the PSCOG Executive, on June 24, 1976, approved funding for the Commuter Pool Program in the amount of \$211,111 (including \$190,000 FAM funds) for FY 1977,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

That King County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a memorandum agreement with the City of Seattle to jointly participate in the formulation, implementation, and evaluation of carpooling and other related efforts

oriented at increasing vehicle occupancy.
