2 A MOTION of the King County Council
3 authorizing the County Executive to
4 execute a memorandum agreement for
5 joint participation in a feasibility
6 study for the "West Seattle Bridge."

7 WHEREAS, the Spokane Street corridor is the primary
8 traffic link between the City of Seattle, its surrounding areas,
9 and the West Seattle resident community; and

10 WHEREAS, the travel volume along this corridor, approxi-
11 mately 90,000 people daily, is the second highest in the
12 state; and

13 WHEREAS, an improved corridor will assist the economic
14 interest of state, regional, and local governments by enhancing
15 economic development on the Duwamish Waterway; and

16 WHEREAS, the legislature of the State of Washington in 1975
17 recognized the importance of this corridor to the State by
18 commissioning a study to be conducted under the supervision of
19 the Washington State Highway Commission which purpose was to
20 further study the development of an improved high level
21 crossing; and

22 WHEREAS, the five governmental units which are parties to
23 this agreement wish to further define, in a cooperative fashion,
24 a course of action which will result in the development of an
25 improved high level crossing in the interest of the public.


26 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

27 The King County Executive is hereby authorized to execute
28 a memorandum agreement between the Washington State Highway
29 Commission, City of Seattle, Port of Seattle and Municipality
30 of Metropolitan Seattle in a cooperative effort to develop
31 recommendation on a legally and financially feasible method of
32 an improved high level crossing of the Duwamish River Waterway

1 to West Seattle (attached) and further is authorized to
2 prepare an appropriation of funds in the amount of \$2,500.00
3 to support the joint committee activities.
