A MOTION adopting the 1977 King County Developmental Disabilities Program Plan and authorizing the County Executive to transmit it to the State of Washington, Department of Social and Health Services.

WHEREAS, the State of Washington declares in RCW 71.20 that it is state policy to cooperate with communities to encourage the establishment and development of services to the developmentally disabled through locally administered and locally controlled programs, and

WHEREAS, state law authorizes the appointment of a community board to plan services for the developmentally disabled, and

WHEREAS, King County by Ordinance No. 1846 created the King County Board for the Developmentally Disabled with duties, services and powers as established by state law, and

WHEREAS, state law requires that an annual plan for proposed expenditures recommended by the board and adopted by the county council be submitted to the state in order to establish eligibility for reimbursement;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The 1977 King County Developmental Disabilities Program Plan is hereby adopted by the Council of King County.


2. The county executive is hereby authorized and directed to transmit the 1977 King County Developmental Disabilities Program Plan to the State of Washington, Department of Social and Health Services, for its consideration and approval.

3. Approval of this motion is sufficient to satisfy the conditions contained in Section 46(4) of Ordinance No. 2988 relating to expenditure of funds from grant awards in 1977.


1           4. It is the intent of the council as expressed in  
 2 Ordinance No. 2988, Section 46(1) that a fee schedule for clients  
 3 of developmental disabilities be developed by April 1, 1977.  
 4 Council and executive staff are directed to begin discussions by  
 5 January, 1977, with the State of Washington for the purpose of  
 6 enacting, by legislation or regulation, a fee schedule based on  
 7 ability to pay.
