A MOTION of the King County Council of King County, Washington, retaining bond counsel for certain services in connection with the sale, issuance and delivery of General Obligation Bonds of the County for public hospital purposes.

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and in the best interest of King County and its inhabitants that the County carry out the public hospital purposes set forth in Ordinance No. 2831 of the County passed August 16, 1976, and in order to provide part of the funds necessary therefor that it now publicly sell and issue \$19,500,000 par value of unlimited tax levy general obligation bonds authorized by said Ordinance and approved by the qualified electors of the County on November 2, 1976 to accomplish such purposes; and

WHEREAS, it is further deemed necessary that nationally recognized attorneys experienced in such matters be retained as bond counsel to participate with the King County Prosecuting Attorney in drafting the ordinance, notices and other documents necessary for the issuance, sale and delivery of said bonds and to give their opinion as to the validity thereof at the time of their delivery;

BE IT MOVED that Preston, Thorgrimson, Ellis, Holman & Fletcher, attorneys at law of Seattle, Washington are hereby employed by the County as bond counsel to participate with the King County Prosecuting Attorney in drafting the ordinances, notices and other documents required by the County for the issuance and sale of its General Obligation Bonds in the total principal amount of \$19,500,000 payable from annual tax levies to be made without limitation as to rate or amount and issued to provide the money necessary to pay part of the cost of acquisition, development and improvement of the facilities of the Harborview

Medical Center as authorized by Ordinance No. 2831 of the County all as duly approved by the qualified electors of the County at a special election held therein on November 2, 1976. services to be rendered by bond counsel will include participation in the drafting of the ordinance, receipts, notices and other documents required for the issuance, sale and delivery of the bonds, the review of the Official Statement prepared by the County for such sale and the furnishing of opinion as to the validity of such bonds at the time of their delivery.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED that the County shall pay bond counsel as compensation the sum of \$13,000 for the services described above together with any actual out-of-pocket expenses incurred by them in performing such services, other than office Payment shall be made out of proceeds of the sale of the bonds when and as issued. The County shall furnish bond counsel at their office in Seattle, Washington, with a complete certified transcript of all proceedings taken in the issuance of the bonds.
