A MOTION expressing Council intent as to procedures and schedules to be followed during the development of the East Sammamish Communities Plan.

WHEREAS, preliminary study has been initiated by the Planning Division on the East Sammamish Communities Plan, and

WHEREAS, procedures, responsibilities and schedules have not been expressly defined, and

WHEREAS, a Community Plan when adopted by the County
Council represents the official short range development and
capital improvement program policy for a community, and

WHEREAS, a Community Plan provides the link between general county-wide policies, plans and programs and specific implementation programs for a community, and

WHEREAS, a Community Plan can also be utilized by other governmental agencies when making decisions concerning community development;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- (1) The Policy Development Commission shall be responsible for all community involvement activities for the community plan; and shall exercise its responsibility through its Community Development Committee and the community involvement coordinator assigned to the community plan.
- (2) A twenty member East Sammamish Communities Plan

 Committee shall be appointed for the community plan: ten members

 to be appointed by the County Executive and ten members to be

 appointed by the Council.
- (3) The chairman of the East Sammamish Communities Plan

 Committee shall be named by the Chairman of the Policy Development

 Commission in consultation with the County Executive and the

 Council.

- (4) The East Sammamish Communities Plan Committee shall be thoroughly briefed concerning the scope of the proposed plan, exisiting plans and policies applicable to the area, available funds for the implementation of plan proposals, the relationship of the committee to the staff, the Policy Development Commission, and to elected officials, and any other information necessary to clearly delineate the committee's role and responsibilities.
- The following schedule for plan development and completion shall be adhered to:
- (a) February 28, 1977: Initial community meeting(s) conducted.
- May 31, 1977: Preliminary draft plan completed and (b) presented to the community.
- September 1, 1977: Final draft plan completed and transmitted to the Council.
- The Community Plan Committee shall be responsible for (6) the development of the East Lake Sammamish Communities Plan.

The Planning Division shall prepare proposed policy, program and map alternatives, and the Committee shall work with the Department to review and evaluate the proposed alternatives and propose additional alternatives where needed.
