2 A MOTION setting the date of hearing on a
3 Final Assessment Roll for King County Road
4 Improvement District No. 46 (Streets in Plat
of St. Francis Wood)

5 WHEREAS, on April 28, 1975, the County Council of King
6 County, Washington passed Ordinance No. 2354 establishing King
7 County Road Improvement District No. 46, and

8 WHEREAS, the construction of the improvement has now been
9 completed, and the exact cost of the improvement is now known, and

10 WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 2354 directed the Director
11 of the Department of Public Works and Transportation, upon
12 determination of the cost of the improvement, to prepare and file
13 with the Clerk of the King County Council an Assessment Roll for
14 that portion of the entire cost and expense of said improvement
15 to be assessed against the property included within Road
16 Improvement District No. 46, and

17 WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works and
18 Transportation has now prepared and filed said Final Assessment
19 Roll with the Clerk of the King County Council.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

21 1. Pursuant to the provisions of R.C.W. 36.88.090, the
22 hearing upon the Final Assessment Roll for King County Road
23 Improvement District No. 46 shall be scheduled for January 31,
24 1977, at 9:30 a.m.

25 2. The King County Council will sit as a board of equaliza-
26 tion for the purpose of considering aforesaid assessment roll at
27 aforesaid hearing or hearings and will consider such objections
28 as are made thereto or any part thereof, and will correct, revise,
29 raise, lower, change or modify said rolls or any part thereof, or
30 set aside said roll in order that such assessment be made de novo
31 as to such body shall appear just and equitable and then proceed
32 to confirm the same by ordinance.
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1 3. The Clerk of the King County Council is hereby directed
 2 to give notice of hearing upon said roll to all owners or reputed
 3 owners of the property whose name appears thereon by mailing a
 4 notice thereof at least fifteen days before the date fixed for
 5 the hearing to such owners or reputed owners at the address of
 6 such as shown on the tax rolls of the County Comptroller, in
 7 addition thereto, such notices shall be published at least two
 8 times in a newspaper of general circulation in the County. Such
 9 notices shall specify the time and place of hearing on said roll
 10 and shall notify all persons who may desire to object thereto to
 11 make such objections in writing and to file same with the Clerk
 12 of the Council at or prior to the date fixed for said hearing.
