## MOTION NO.

A MOTION relating to the 1977 Housing and Community Development Block Grant, specifying projects and allocations for the County's Population Fund and transmitting projects to the Joint Policy Committee for consideration for Countywide Needs Funds.

WHEREAS, the King County urban county consortium, composed of King County, twenty-six suburban cities and the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe, will receive approximately \$5,452,000 for its 1977 Housing and Community Development Program, and

WHEREAS, King County will be entitled to approximately \$1,942,204 in funds based upon its population, and

WHEREAS, King County is eligible to compete for approximately \$1,553,768 in funds based upon need;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
