A MOTION expressing Council approval of the increases in rates and charges proposed by Cablevision, a subsidiary of Viacom International, Inc., to take effect March 1, 1977

WHEREAS, Viacom International, Inc. is authorized to operate a CATV system in portions of unincorporated King County lying northerly and easterly of Lake Washington, under franchise agreements designated as 548, 549, 550, 559, 569, 614 and 561, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council is authorized by ordinance and franchise agreements to regulate rates and services relative to cable television services, and

WHEREAS, Cablevision, a subsidiary of Viacom International, Inc. has proposed a rate increase from \$ 7.75 per month to \$ 8.50 per month, and

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle hearing Examiner, on the authority delegated by the Seattle and King County Councils, approved a rate increase for Teleprompter Corporation from \$ 7.75 to \$ 8.50 per month, and

WHEREAS, the rate increases proposed by Cablevision, a subsidiary of Viacom International, Inc., are within the range approved by the City of Seattle Hearing Examiner.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The monthly rate increase proposed by Cablevision from \$ 7.75 to \$ 8.50 per month is found to be in the public interest and is approved, effective March 1, 1977.
