2 A MOTION establishing a uniform King County  
3 policy for providing services on a contractual  
4 basis to governmental agencies.

5 WHEREAS, the King County Council recognizes that  
6 governmental jurisdictions contract for services with a number  
7 of County departments, and

8 WHEREAS, the King County Council recognizes that there are  
9 mutual cost benefits to be derived from expanding intergovern-  
10 mental contracting services, and

11 WHEREAS, the King County Council acknowledges the need to  
12 establish a uniform rate structure for contractual services  
13 which accurately reflect the cost of providing such services,  
14 and

15 WHEREAS, the King County Council sees a need to distribute  
16 accurate and complete information to local jurisdictions  
17 regarding services provided by the County, enabling jurisdictions  
18 to avail themselves of County services on a contractual basis,  
19 and

20 WHEREAS, the King County Council recognizes the need to  
21 establish a standard contract for the use of all County depart-  
22 ments and local jurisdictions.

23 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

24 That the County Executive develop and implement a standard  
25 contract for all services provided by County departments, and

26 That the County Executive establish administrative policies  
27 and procedures which assure the uniform treatment of all  
28 jurisdictions wishing to contract for County services, and

29 That the County Executive, in consultation with County  
30 departments and local jurisdictions, review existing County  
31 contracts and move toward the establishment of a rate structure  
32 which accurately reflects the direct and indirect costs to the  
33

1 County of providing services under contract, and is equitable  
2 among local jurisdictions, and

3 That the County Executive submit a proposed rate schedule  
4 to the County Council for approval August 1, 1977, and

5 That the County Executive provide complete and accurate  
6 information on available services and contract rates to  
7 interested jurisdictions throughout the County, and actively  
8 encourage their use of said services.
