A MOTION relating to the Puget Sound Health Systems Agency and adopting comments on the agency's application for second-year funding.

WHEREAS, the Puget Sound Council of Governments, in its metropolitan clearinghouse capacity under O.M.B. circular A-95, has received an application from the Puget Sound Health Systems Agency for funding its second year of operation, and

WHEREAS, the A-95 process incorporates comments from local jurisdictions, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has expressed strong disapproval of both the federal legislation under which the agency was established and the process by which the agency was designated by the U. S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council desires to bring its position to the attention of the elected officials in the four-county region served by the Puget Sound Council of Governments;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Council reaffirms its position of protesting both P.L. 93-641, the National Health Planning and Resource Development Act of 1974, and also the manner in which the Puget Sound Health Systems Agency was designated by the U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare.
