

MOTION NO. 2877

A MOTION concurring with the recommendation of the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner on the application for reclassification petitioned by PETER SELBECK, designated Building and Land Development File No. 173-76-R and deleting a condition thereto.

WHEREAS, the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner by report dated November 23, 1976 has recommended that the application for reclassification petitioned by PETER SELBECK, designated Building and Land Development File No. 173-76-R be approved for BC-P, in lieu of BC, subject to certain requirements; and

WHEREAS, one of the recommended requirements in that report has been appealed by the applicant; and

WHEREAS, the ~~the~~ appealed requirement has been substantially met by the applicant since the report of the Deputy Examiner was written and the Council finds the said requirement to be no longer applicable,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The subject reclassification petitioned by PETER SELBECK, designated Building and Land Development File No. 173-76-R is approved for BC-P as recommended by the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner in his report dated November 23, 1976 and that Post-Ordinance Condition No. 2, page 5 is deleted.
