

A MOTION requesting the Building and Land Development Division and the Department of Public Works to monitor traffic and parking requirements for hotels in the vicinity of Sea-Tac International Airport.

WHEREAS, the County Council, through Proposed Ordinance
No. 76-729, is considering a reduction in off-street parking
requirements for hotels within a specified distance of Sea-Tac
International Airport on the basis that a major portion of their
customers arrive by air, and

WHEREAS, the area in question, namely State Highway 99 just east of the airport, is already a heavily traveled thoroughfare and concern has been expressed about the adverse impact of reducing the supply of off-street parking in the area,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

If Proposed Ordinance No. 76-729 is passed, the Building and Land Development Division and the Traffic and Planning Division of Public Works are requested to monitor traffic flows and parking demand within the area specified in the proposed ordinance, to determine if the reduced hotel parking requirement results in adverse impacts on adjacent properties, motorists,
