12 A MOTION requesting the Building and Land Develop-  
13 ment Division and the Department of Public Works  
14 to monitor traffic and parking requirements for  
hotels in the vicinity of Sea-Tac International  
Airport.

15 WHEREAS, the County Council, through Proposed Ordinance  
16 No. 76-729, is considering a reduction in off-street parking  
17 requirements for hotels within a specified distance of Sea-Tac  
18 International Airport on the basis that a major portion of their  
19 customers arrive by air, and

20 WHEREAS, the area in question, namely State Highway 99 just  
21 east of the airport, is already a heavily traveled thoroughfare  
22 and concern has been expressed about the adverse impact of  
23 reducing the supply of off-street parking in the area,

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

25 If Proposed Ordinance No. 76-729 is passed, the Building  
26 and Land Development Division and the Traffic and Planning Divi-  
27 sion of Public Works are requested to monitor traffic flows and  
28 parking demand within the area specified in the proposed ordin-  
29 ance, to determine if the reduced hotel parking requirement  
30 results in adverse impacts on adjacent properties, motorists,

1 and airport hotel customers. The Divisions are requested to  
2 report their findings to the Council two years from the effective  
3 date of the proposed ordinance.
