A MOTION relating to the Interdisciplinary Team Final Report SR 522: Interstate 5 to 80th Avenue Northeast, approving in principle the two recommendations contained therein and directing the Council Clerk to notify the contributing governmental agencies of this action.

WHEREAS, there is considerable congestion on the SR 522 corridor from Interstate 5 to 80th Avenue Northeast, and travel demand forecasts indicate continuing increases, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to improve the safety and to develop additional person carrying capacity through this corridor, and

WHEREAS, under the direction of the Washington State

Department of Highways, an Interdisciplinary Team was formed to
address the problems and recommend various alternate solutions,
and

WHEREAS, the Interdisciplinary Team has conducted the study in accordance with "An Action Plan for Social, Economic and Environmental Considerations in the Planning, Location and Design of Highways", and

WHEREAS, the Team has had an extensive citizen involvement program including five workshops and almost continuing dialogue with various citizen groups and governmental agencies, and

WHEREAS, the Final Report of the Interdisciplinary Team SR 522: Interstate 5 to 80th Avenue Northeast was reviewed by the Public Facilities and Utilities Committee of the King County Council on March 14, 1977, and was accepted and approved in principle as to the recommendations contained therein,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Council hereby accepts the "Interdisciplinary Team Final Report SR 522: Interstate 5 to 80th Avenue Northeast", and approves in principle the Report's two recommendations:

1. Operational and Safety Improvements on SR 522, as

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outlined on Page 11 of the Report, and

2. Transit Alternate C: East-West Feeder Service, as outlined on Page 19 of the Report, and

BE IT FURTHER MOVED, the Council Clerk is hereby directed to notify the contributing governmental agencies of this action, namely the cities of Seattle and Lake Forest Park, the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle (METRO), the Puget Sound Council of Governments, and the Washington State Highway Commission, Department of Highways.
