MOTION NO. 02946

A MOTION establishing a Shoreline  
Communities Plan Committee.

WHEREAS, preliminary study has been initiated by the Planning  
Division on the Shoreline Communities Plan, and

WHEREAS, a Communities Plan when adopted by the County  
Council represents the official development and capital improvement  
program policy for a community, and

WHEREAS, a Communities Plan provides the link between general  
county-wide policies, plans and programs and specific implementa-  
tion programs for a community, and

WHEREAS, a Communities Plan can also be utilized by other  
governmental agencies when making decisions concerning  
community development.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

There is hereby established a twenty-one member Shoreline  
Communities Plan Committee to be appointed as follows:

1. Ten (10) members to be appointed by the Councilperson  
from District No. 1;
2. Ten (10) members to be appointed by the County Executive;  
and
3. A chairperson appointed by the Chairperson of the Policy  
Development Commission.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Shoreline Communities Plan Committee shall:

1. Be responsible for developing the Shoreline Community  
Involvement Process and executing the program with the assistance  
of the Community Involvement Coordinator assigned to the community  
plan.
2. Advise the Council and the Executive on community  
attitudes and desires.
3. Assist the Planning Division in developing proposed  
policies, programs and map alternatives for the community.

1 4. Recommend and submit a Community Plan to the Council and  
2 Executive along with any alternatives the Committee or the  
3 Planning Division may wish to include.

4 BE IT FURTHER MOVED by the Council of King County:

5 The Planning Division shall:

6 1. Prepare preliminary community profiles and compile  
7 existing plans and policies applicable to the area.

8 2. Prepare for review proposed policies, programs, and  
9 map alternatives.

10 3. Advise the Committee of probable impacts of proposed  
11 policies, programs and map alternatives and identify any inconsis-  
12 tent or unimplementable policies, programs and map alternatives  
13 under consideration.

14 4. Prepare preliminary and final Community Plan documents  
15 and Environmental Impact Statements.

16 BE IT FURTHER MOVED by the Council of King County:

17 1. The scope of the Shoreline Communities Plan shall be  
18 principally concerned with areas of land use, transportation,  
19 recreation, and related capital improvement programs planned for  
20 implementation in the next six to twelve years.

21 2. The schedule for completion of the Shoreline Communities  
22 Plan will be as follows:

23 (a) April 28, 1977: Initial community meetings conducted.

24 (b) September 29, 1977: Preliminary draft plan completed and  
25 presented to the community.

26 (c) December 22, 1977: Final draft plan completed and  
27 transmitted to the Council.
