

1 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive
2 to grant an easement in favor of Water
3 District No. 107 at Lake Boren Park.

4 WHEREAS, Water District No. 107 has made plans to install
5 and maintain a water pipeline with connections, manholes, and
6 appurtenances on certain lands owned by King County, and located
7 in Lake Boren Park, and

8 WHEREAS, Water District No. 107 has bargained for a per-
9 petual easement over, across, along, in, upon, and under the
10 aforementioned County lands to be conveyed to Water District
11 No. 107 for the purpose of installing and maintaining a water
12 pipeline with connections, manholes and appurtenances, and

13 WHEREAS, the King County Council has determined it to be
14 necessary and in the best interests of the citizens of King
15 County that the said easement be granted in and for the consi-
16 deration of Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars,

17 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

18 The County Executive is hereby authorized to sign and de-
19 liver the necessary water line easement, granting to Water
20 District No. 107 an easement over, across, along, in, upon and
21 under County owned property situated in King County and more
22 particularly described as follows:

23 A strip of land 10 feet wide, being 5 feet on each
24 side of the following described centerline:

25 Beginning at the Northeast corner of the West 70
26 feet of the South 75 feet of the SW 1/4 of the SE
27 1/4 of Section 28, Township 24 North, Range 5
28 East, W.M.; thence South parallel to the West line
29 of said subdivision 24 feet; thence Southwesterly
30 to a point on the south line of said Section 28, a
31 distance of 19.52 feet East of the South Quarter
32 corner of said subdivision and the terminus of
33 said line; All lying within: The SW 1/4 of the
SE 1/4 Less the North 633.71 feet of said Section.

Together with, a temporary right of way or ease-
ment to be used only during construction of water
line on adjacent property. The said temporary
right of way or easement shall be through and
across the property described herein, situated in
King County, Washington, and more particularly
described as follows:

A strip of land 20 feet in width extending for 10
feet on each side of the centerline described

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herein.
