2 A MOTION requesting that the Executive form
3 a Pacific Northwest International Performing
4 Arts Theater Complex Advisory Committee, to
5 advise general government on the location,
6 construction and use of a performing arts
7 theater complex in King County.

8 WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature is currently
9 considering House Bill Number 777, a bill which would appropri-
10 ate five million dollars for the construction of a performing
11 arts theater complex on privately donated property in South
12 King County, and

13 WHEREAS, during the 44th session of the Washington State
14 Legislature, the state granted \$100,000 to the Seattle Opera
15 Association to select an economically feasible site for the
16 development of a performing arts complex, to include an annual
17 summer music festival, and

18 WHEREAS, a study was performed by Economic Research
19 Association and the Moss, Adams Company which determined that
20 a location in South King County was economically feasible, and

21 WHEREAS, the social benefits to the community of the
22 proposed performing arts theater complex can be easily inferred,
23 and

24 WHEREAS, economic studies have clearly indicated the
25 potential commercial and economic development impact of such
26 a facility on tourism and community growth, and

27 WHEREAS, public discussion of the location, construction
28 and uses of the proposed facility should be continuing as
29 the project evolves over time, and

30 WHEREAS, organizations involved in the performing arts
31 in the Seattle-King County area should have a meaningful role
32 in advising general government on activities directly related
33 to implementing the project, and

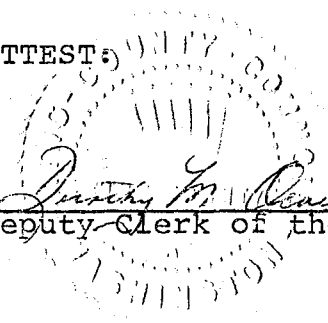
