2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to
3 make a grant application for funds in the
4 approximate amount of \$1,086,701 to support
the Center for Addiction Services, Grant File
No. 704:2.

5 WHEREAS, the Drug Abuse and Treatment Act of 1972, as
6 amended, provides for the award of grants by the Department of
7 Health, Education and Welfare, and

8 WHEREAS, the Department of Health, Education and Welfare,
9 National Institute on Drug Abuse, is empowered to make grants to
10 support treatment services to drug abusers, and

11 WHEREAS, the Center for Addiction Services will assist the
12 County in meeting the needs of drug abusers through a program of
13 detoxification, maintenance, residential, counseling, referral
14 and follow-up services to facilitate rehabilitation, and

15 WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds that provision of
16 such services is in the public interest, and

17 WHEREAS, the Council recognizes an obligation to provide the
18 amount of \$12,500 as a cash match in support of the project,

19 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

20 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make
21 application for funds in the approximate amount of \$1,086,701 to
22 the National Institute on Drug Abuse on behalf of King County;
23 PROVIDED THAT, prior to July 1, 1977, the Executive shall present
24 to the Health and Human Services Committee of the Council
25 alternative proposals for County participation in program
26 management of the drug treatment systems; PROVIDED FURTHER THAT,
27 prior to July 1, 1977, the Executive shall present to the Health
28 and Human Services Committee guidelines under which persons may
29 be maintained through public funds on methadone for longer than
30 two years;

31 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file
32 and execute such application and contracts as are required by the
33 grantor;

1 3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter
2 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the
3 implementation of the project;

4 4. The Department of Health, Education and Welfare,
5 National Institute on Drug Abuse is hereby assured full
6 compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
