A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute a Quit Claim Deed to the State of Washington of certain right of way across Reserve No. 1 of Hillman's Meadow Gardens No. 2.

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WHEREAS, King County acquired by deed under Auditor's File No. 621470, dated May 20, 1909, certain right of way from the Oregon and Washington Railroad Company, said right of way being referred to as Strip A, and being more particularly described below, and

WHEREAS, Strip A was acquired by King County as a connector between two County railroad crossings, and

WHEREAS, the major portion of Strip A, now lying within SR5, South 126th Street to Norfolk Street, has already been acquired by the State of Washington under general county road deed, King County Auditor's File No. 5661899, and

WHEREAS, the remaining portion of Strip A retained by the County is still part of the county road system, and

WHEREAS, the Dept. of Public Works has expressly determined that such remaining portion is of no further value to the County for road purposes, and

WHEREAS, said remaining portion would be of value to the State of Washington, Dept. of Highways, for road purposes in connection with the State maintained SR5, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council does hereby determine that the remaining portion of Strip A is no longer necessary for County road purposes, and deems it necessary and in the best interests of the citizens of King County and the State of Washington to transfer said Strip A to the State of Washington,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute and deliver to the State of Washington a Quit Claim Deed for Strip A, being more particularly described as follows:

STRIP A - A strip of land 40 feet in width across Reserve No. 1 of Hillman's Meadow Gardens No. 2 as shown by the recorded plat thereof on file in the

Office of the Auditor of said King County to connect with the County road crossing under Northern Pacific Railway and Columbia & Puget Sound Railway to conform to the one now in existence; said strip of land being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the Northwesterly line of said Reserve No. 1 said point being South 61°43'15" West 130 feet, more or less, measured along the said Northwesterly line from the most Northerly corner of said Reserve No. 1; thence continuing South 61°43' 15" West a distance of 44 feet, more or less; thence South 3°08' East a distance of 73 feet, more or less; thence South 50°44' West a distance of 47 feet, more or less, to the Westerly line of said Reserve No. 1; thence South 12°54'12" East along said Westerly line thence South 12°54'12" East along said Westerly line of Reserve No. 1, a distance of 44.5 feet, more or less; thence North 50°44' East a distance of 87 feet, more or less; thence North 3°08' West a distance of 112 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning.
