A MOTION naming the previously unnamed boat launch at John McDonald Park the Orville Pence Boat Launch.

WHEREAS, the late Orville Pence, having served with distinction for many years on the King County Park Board, and having been instrumental in the effort to acquire the 230-acre John McDonald Park for the citizens of King County, and

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that Dr. Pence be honored for his interest and service to the citizens of King County, and

WHEREAS, Dr. Pence was an avid fisherman and spent many hours fishing at John McDonald Park,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The boat launch at John McDonald Park hereafter be officially named the "Orville Pence Boat Launch".
