A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$25,000 to support the Shoreline: Transportation implementation Strategy Study, Grant File No. 719:2.

WHEREAS, the purposes, objectives and activities of the study have been coordinated through the Puget Sound Council of Governments; and

WHEREAS, the Puget Sound Council of Governments completed and adopted the Highway and Transit elements of the 1990 Transportation System Plan on February 14, 1974 thereby assuring the eligibility of state and local transportation facilities for capital grants-in-aid by the Federal Highway Administration and the Urban Mass Transportation Administration; and

WHEREAS, the study will enhance the refinement of regional transportation issues and plans as expressed in the Puget Sound Council of Governments' Resolution adopted June 20, 1974; and

WHEREAS, the Urban Mass Transportation Administration Act of 1964, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$6,250 as an in-kind contribution in support of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$25,000 to the Department of Transportation, Urban Mass Transportation Administration;
- 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;
